ENROLMENT TAKES JUST TEN STEPS:

1

FIND A PLACEMENT

Find a church or para-church that is willing to take you on as an intern, and have the church/para-church leader complete the online Internship Placement form. This step must be completed before submitting an enrolment form.

2

THE ENROLMENT FORM

Go to our website and fill in the online enrolment form

3

THE REFEREE REPORTS

Find two referees and have them fill in referee reports.

4

PAY THE APPLICATION FEE

There is an application fee of \$100 which needs to be paid when you submit your enrolment form. If your enrolment form and fee are submitted before the enrolment cut off date, the fee will be discounted to \$50.

5

WAIT FOR US TO CONTACT YOU

We'll contact you to let you know whether you've been accepted to study at Pathways, and we'll let you know if we need any more information from you.

6

PHOTOCOPY YOUR PASSPORT

Email a photocopy of the information page of your passport to enrolments@pathways.ac.nz. Once you arrive in New Zealand, Pathways staff will need to see the original passport.

7

APPLY FOR A STUDENT VISA

You will need to meet all New Zealand Immigration Requirements and apply online for a student visa at: <https://www.immigration.govt.nz/new-zealand-visas/options/study>.

In order to complete this step, you will need a letter from Pathways confirming that your enrolment has been accepted.

8

COMPLETE AN IELTS TEST

You will need to complete an IELTS English language proficiency test with a result of 5.5 or more with no band less than 5. Once you arrive in New Zealand, Pathways staff will need to see the original IELTS documents.

9

OBTAIN MEDICAL INSURANCE

You'll need to organise medical insurance for yourself covering the period of time you will be in NZ

10

PAY YOUR FEES

All fees will need to be paid in full before your student visa can be approved. Until fees are paid the visa will be conditional and your study at Pathways College cannot begin.

ENTRY CRITERIA

- You must be 18 or older on or before the first day of study
- Minimum NCEA level 2 or higher, or its equivalent (original documents will need to be sighted by Pathways staff on arrival in NZ)
- All fees must be paid in full by the start of study
- Applicants must have an approved internship placement
- English language proficiency: IELTS result of 5.5 or more with no band less than 5 (original documents will need to be sighted by Pathways staff on arrival in NZ). Some countries where English is considered their main language are exempt from this rule. Contact the College if unsure.
- Must have a NZ Student Visa covering the period of study (original documents will need to be sighted by Pathways staff on arrival in NZ)
- Must have medical insurance covering the period of study (original documents will need to be sighted by Pathways staff on arrival in NZ)
